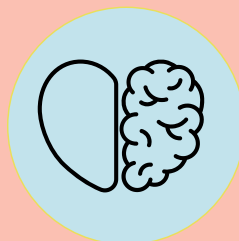
I've lived on the Wirral for 25 years but I'm from Walton in Liverpool.
